

Children's Lesson- What is Communion?

Watch the video, then discuss together and pray.

Bible Passage: Luke 22:19

Main point: Jesus gave us a way to remember Him!

Discussion Questions:

-What part of communion represents Jesus' body? (*the Bread*) What part of communion represents Jesus' blood? (*the juice*)

-T/F Partaking in Communion is for everyone that thinks God is real. (*FALSE! We need to choose Jesus as our Lord and Savior before we should take communion! Communion is only for those who believe Jesus died and rose from the dead for their sins*)

-Our verse today describes what the tradition of communion is really about... why do we have the tradition of communion? (*to remember Jesus' sacrifice and God's great love for us!*)

-Do you have to be an adult to take communion? (*Nope! Anyone, any age who believes in Jesus as Lord and Savior can join this tradition*)

Pray together: Dear Jesus, when we see bread and juice, help us to remember you... We remember you today, that your body was broken for us, that we may have everlasting life, Thank you! In Jesus name, Amen.
